Topics of Discussion:

- Reviewal of the Public Hearing on the Rezoning of the Orinoco Corridor. Reviewed the different zonings that allowed for apartments.
- Mechanical Harvester The Mayor is looking to purchase the mechanical harvester to remedy the overabundance of lily pads and invasive weeds in the lakes. There could be other solutions but the options now are either to hire them to come back and
- Service Roads The Service Roads in the village need repair. Looking into which ones
 are a priority and possibly splitting into sections. The NYSDOT CHIPS Reimbursement
 is no longer reimbursing for bond payments. Also, roads that need paving are Plymouth
 Court, Johnson Drive.
- Flyer went out for the Traffic Concerns / Pedestrian Safety Meeting being held on January 29th.
- Planning Board is reviewing the code on the storage of campers and trailers.
- Summer camp moved up to March for registration. Will be taking in 100 campers.
- Alpha Carting is asking for a 12% increase for the first year and zero on the second year
 to extend the Garbage contract for 2 years. When we went out to bid the Alpha's prices
 were much lower than Winter Bros. Put on next agenda for a vote.
- Follow up with Engineer Dan Falasco on a price for the breakwater at Walker Beach Boat Basin.
